

ECO ABROLHOS PASSENGER INFO



WHAT IS INCLUDED:

- Breakfast, lunch and dinner, morning and afternoon teas
- Self serve tea, coffee and biscuits (24 hours)
- Chilled and filtered drinking water
- All tours except optional tours
- All linen incl beach towels are supplied
- Shampoo, conditioner and hairdryer in all ensuites
- Fishing - rods & reels, bait, tackle and lures supplied
- Laundry service
- Complimentary transfers at beginning & end of each tour

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED:

- Alcohol. The Vessel is licensed and drinks are available from the bars between 12.00 - 9.00pm. Drinks are charged to your room. **Strictly no BYO.**
- Soft drink and bottled water
- Espresso coffee - available at the lower bar all day
- Optional Tours: Helicopter Flights/Horizontal Falls fast boat

WHAT TO BRING:

- **Face Masks** (in case of mandatory COVID regs)
- **Proof of Triple Vaccination**
- Water Bottle plus small backpack for excursions
- A spray jacket or wet weather jacket
- Bathers
- A hat (one with a chin strap is preferred)
- Sunglasses (Polarized Sunglasses are best suited for this type of trip). We recommend that you bring a lanyard for your glasses to prevent loss in the water
- Shoes for walks that will get wet (reef walking shoes/crocs)
- Warmer clothing for evenings or outside
- Camera (and binoculars if you're a keen bird watcher)
- Sea sick medication (If required)
- Sun cream
- A "Hawaiian" themed outfit for Hawaiian night

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

Please bring with you any Travel Insurance papers as medical evacuation is expensive from the Kimberley. We strongly recommend that all passengers have Travel insurance to cover unexpected tour cancellation, and medical evacuation.

BOARDING @ WYNDHAM

On the evening prior to departure from Wyndham, a representative will meet you to administer a RAT, temperature check, and complete a Health Declaration. There will be a charge of \$12pp for the TGA approved 'Very High Sensitivity' RAT (this will be added to your Bar Tab). A more exact time will be communicated to you closer to departure. Boarding will be by bus transfer from your accommodation in Kununurra from 7.00am

DEPARTURE @ BROOME

Disembarkation in Broome will be at approx. 9am. Occasionally this may be delayed due to weather conditions at the port. Our transfer bus will then take you to your requested ongoing accommodation/travel stops in Broome. ETA is 10am so if you were booking ongoing flights, we recommend that you fly after 2.00pm to allow sufficient time for delays.

VESSEL INDUCTION

By law all guests must have a vessel induction onboard the Eco Abrolhos prior to departure. There will also be a compulsory life jacket and muster station drill for all guests within the first 24 hours after departure.

WHAT IS AVAILABLE ONBOARD


- A small gift shop is onboard. Items include Eco Abrolhos shirts, jumpers, hats, caps, stubby holders, water bottles, postcards.
- A fully licensed bar. Beer, wine, spirits, soft drink, bottled water and expresso coffees are available.
- All onboard purchases will be charged to your room.
- Settlement of the account will be required prior to disembarking.
- Visa, Mastercard or cash will be accepted.
- As we are a fully licensed premise, BYO is not permitted.
