Broome to Wyndham Cruise



WHAT IS INCLUDED:

- Breakfast, lunch, dinner, morning and afternoon teas
- Self serve tea, coffee and biscuits (24 hours)
- Chilled and filtered drinking water
- All tours except optional extras tours
- All linen incl beach towels
- Shampoo, conditioner and hairdryer in all ensuites
- Fishing - rods & reels, bait, tackle and lures
- Laundry service
- Complimentary transfers at beginning & end of cruise

WHAT IS NOT INCLUDED:

- Alcohol. The Vessel is licensed and drinks are available from the main deck bar between 12.00 - 9.00. Drinks are charged to your room. **Strictly no BYO.**
- Soft drink and bottled water
- Espresso coffee - available at the main deck bar all day
- Optional Tours: Helicopter Flights/Horizontal Falls fast boat - subject to 3rd Party availability

WHAT TO BRING:

- Water Bottle plus small backpack for excursions
- A spray jacket or wet weather jacket
- Bathers
- A hat (one with a chin strap is preferred)
- Sunglasses (Polarized Sunglasses are best suited). We recommend a lanyard for your glasses to prevent loss in the water
- Shoes for walks that can get wet
- Warmer clothing for evenings or outside
- Camera (and binoculars if you're a keen bird watcher)
- Seasick medication (if required)
- Sun cream
- A "Hawaiian" themed outfit for Hawaiian night

TRAVEL INSURANCE:

We strongly recommend that all passengers have Travel insurance to cover unexpected cruise cancellation, and medical evacuation.

Please bring your Travel Insurance papers.

Medicare/000 will not cover your evacuation costs.

BOARDING in BROOME

The coach will collect you from your Broome accommodation from 8am on the day of Boarding. A more exact time will be communicated closer to departure. Access to the "Eco Abrolhos" will be by tender pickup at Gantheaume Point across Cable Beach. You may get wet up to your knees. Shorts are preferred attire and easy to remove footwear is advisable. All personal items should be packed within your luggage to assist staff with the in-water boarding. **Please be sunsmart - you may be required to wait on the beach whilst tender transfers occur - wear a hat & sunscreen**

DISEMBARKING in WYNDHAM

The Coach will collect you from Wyndham port @ 9am and will make a short stop at 5 Rivers Lookout before continuing to your ongoing accommodation or drop off point in Kununurra. ETA is 11am so if you are booking ongoing flights, we recommend that you fly after 2pm to allow sufficient time for delays.

VESSEL INDUCTION

By law all guests must have a vessel induction onboard the Eco Abrolhos prior to departure. There will also be a compulsory life jacket and muster station drill for all guests within the first 24 hours after departure.

WHAT IS AVAILABLE ONBOARD

- A small gift shop is onboard. Items include Eco Abrolhos shirts, jumpers, hats, caps, stubby holders, water bottles, postcards.
 - A fully licensed bar. Beer, wine, spirits, soft drink, bottled water and espresso coffees are available for purchase.
 - All onboard purchases will be charged to your room tab.
 - Settlement of the account is required prior to disembarking.
- Payment options - Visa, Mastercard or EFTPOS

PHONE & INTERNET RECEPTION

Eco Abrolhos has the Starlink system onboard that provides limited internet access. Access tokens may be purchased onboard (\$50 - 5 Days or \$120 - 14 Days). Mobile reception is virtually nil during the cruise.
